## About the College:

The New College is a Government-Aided Muslim minority College affiliated to the University of Madras. It was founded by the Muslim Educational Association of Southern India (MEASI). Since its founding in 1951 with about 200 intermediate course students, The New College has rigorously upheld commitment to providing quality Higher Education to the deserving students, especially from weaker sections of the society. The college is currently run by a Managing Committee of the MEASI under the chairmanship of noted Chartered Accountant, Janab. U. Mohamed Khalilullah sahib.

On our beautiful campus on Peter's Road, Royapettah, Chennai, about 5000 students pursue their intellectual passion through more than 35 academic programmes. The New college campus also houses three other institutions run by its parent body viz., MEASI Academy of Architecture, MEASI Institute of Management, and MEASI Institute of Information Technology.

Although the college and its allied institutions were established with a view to educationally empower students belonging to the Muslim community in Tamil Nadu, the college has students and teachers from different communities and from almost all parts of India. We have a few students from abroad as well. There is provision for nearly 500 students to reside in the College campus. The parent body of the college uses a major share of income every year to give scholarships to students from economically less privileged families.

The college campus is equipped with all necessary facilities for the all-round development of students including playground, Hostel, fitness centre, Staff Lounge, Library, Canteen, Wi-Fi internet connectivity and so on. Students' Union elections are conducted every year to select student representatives and to inculcate values of democracy in students. The college has two active units of NCC. The units of NSS, Rotaract Club, Youth Red Cross and other social service initiatives of the college won several accolades from different agencies including Chennai city police, and health department for their services.

There is a mosque in the college campus which is open for all for worship and meditation.

The Diamond Jubilee block, the latest addition to the buildings in the campus, is mainly meant for setting up a Digital Library and Resource Centre. The college has been securing many major projects from the UGC and other agencies, and has always endeavoured to produce quality research works. Numerous research papers and books are published by our faculty every year.

The New College became autonomous in the year 2007, and it is recently re-accredited by NAAC with 'A' Grade. Autonomy has enhanced us to periodically update our curriculum, and offer courses that are relevant to the times and aimed at enhancing employability of students. During its existence in the past 62 years, the college has produced about 75,000 graduates, many of whom have excelled in their chosen fields. The college continues to extend its services to the nation by means of adopting healthy practices and dedicated efforts to ensure quality of education.

## About the Department:

The Post Graduate Department of Arabic got affiliated from The University of Madras in the Year 1965. Moulana Abdul Wahab Bhukhari, the then Principal and a great scholar of Arabic, Persian and Urdu took over as the Head of Arabic Department. Dr.Syed Ali was appointed as Lecturer in Arabic. Prof. Md.Yousuf Kokan, Department of Arabic University of Madras, Prof.Syed Azmathullah of History, Presidency College, Moulana Abdul Bari Hawi, Principal, Jamalia Arabic College and Prof. Syed Abdur Razack, Lecturer of History, University of Madras were taking M.A. Arabic Classes as visiting Professors. After retirement of Prof. Abdul Wahab Bukhari Sahib, Dr.Syed Ali became the Head.

In 1982, the department got affiliation for B.A. Arabic Branch XII-J and the strength of students & staff increased

considerably. The Department of Arabic had the privilege for receiving the visiting professors from world famous Al-Azhar University, Cairo, Egypt: Prof. Abdur Rahman Ali Salim, Prof. Nazmi Abdul Badeeh Mohamed, Prof. Hassan Ali Tammam, Prof. Umar Amar Ibrahim, Prof Abdus Salam al Jawhari, Prof. Rajab Mujahid As Sha'ir.

Dr. Syed Ali retired in 1993, as HoD and he has received the President Award from Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma (The former President of India) in the year 1996 for the services rendered towards the development of Arabic Language. Prof. N.Ahmed Basha took over as the Head of the Department. In 1996 & 1999, Department was elevated to Research level by getting recognition from the University of Madras leading to M.Phil., Degree and Ph.D., Degree respectively. Dr.Syed Rahmathullah was the HoD between 2001 and 2003. Dr. Mohamed Sulaiman Umari served as HoD during 2003 -2004. Dr.S.Abdul Maliq has become HoD in 2004, since then he has been organizing several programmes, which include, seminars, workshops, guest lectures and special lectures of Arab delegates etc., Dr.S.Abdul Maliq has been serving as Principal of the college since 2012.
